Communiqué by the 155<sup>th</sup> Ordinary Session of the Council of the League of Arab States at the Ministerial Level

on

Praising the efforts of the State of Kuwait and its endeavours to achieve Arab and Gulf solidarity

The Council of the League of Arab States convened its 155<sup>th</sup> Ordinary Session on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2021, in which the Council expressed its appreciation for the efforts and endeavors made by the State of Kuwait to achieve the desired Arab and Gulf solidarity, which was supported by Arab and international parties, and culminated by the reconciliation that was previously led by the late Amir of the State of Kuwait, His Highness Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah - May Allah rest his soul in peace - to serve the Arab nation issues, and completed by his brother His Highness, Amir of the State of Kuwait, Sheikh Nawaf Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah, stressing that the achieved outcomes will serve the Arab causes and unify visions and positions to address the challenges facing the region.

The Council also valued the efforts of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, King Salman bin Abdulaziz, and HRH Prince Mohammed bin Salman bin Abdulaziz, Deputy Prime Minister for hosting the 41<sup>st</sup> Summit of the Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf, which was titled "Summit of Sultan Qaboos and Sheikh Sabah". The Council also commended the GCC Member States, the Al-Ula Declaration issued thereof, the participation of HE the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the sisterly Arab Republic of Egypt. It is worth mentioning that Al-Ula Declaration emphasized strengthening the bonds of friendship and brotherhood among the peoples of the region, restoring collaboration among all Member States to its natural path, and welcomed the signature of the Arab Republic of Egypt on the Al-Ula Statement, which confirms strengthening brotherly relations between Egypt and GCC states in a way that serves Arab interests.
