







Q1: Was the agenda of the session well organized and easy to follow?

#### Total of 25 respondents




Q2: Did the presenters or instructors provide relevant examples during the training?

#### Total of 25 respondents




# Q3: How would you describe the session pace?

#### Total of 24 respondents





# Q4: Was the session interactive enough?




# Q5: Did the session meet your expectations?
